

River Falls Youth Hockey Association Facility Responsibilities

Members of the River Falls Youth Hockey Association are responsible for facility duties at the River Falls Wildcat Centre Arena between September 1 - March 31.

Facility duties will include, but are not limited to, the opening and closing of the arena, skate sharpening, shoveling snow, changing filters in both heating and dehumidifier systems and helping with maintenance jobs around the Arena when members possess.

Each Team Manager will be responsible for providing the Facility Coordinator with the member that will be responsible for opening and closing when their team is on the calendar. The rink will be opened an hour before a scheduled game and a half hour before a practice.

The shoveling of snow will need to be done in front of the Arena and all exit doors around the arena. This will need to be completed at the time the rink is opened and throughout the day during the winter months. The Team Manager will be responsible for providing two members from their team at minimum responsible for the snow removal.

Each Team Manager will be responsible for finding one volunteer family member from their team who would be interested in sharpening skates. The Team Manager will provide the Facility Coordinator with this information and a training session will be set up.

All hours spent doing the facility duties are considered part of teams responsibility and will not apply toward the required family hourly participation requirement.

Team Managers are accountable for insuring that all facility duties are completed during their assigned date and time. Failure to do so may result in loss of practice time for the team that did not contribute their fair share in taking care of our arena.
