The Chambersburg Youth Soccer Association (CYSA) aims to promote and foster the game of soccer on the youth level. The key element to CYSA's philosophy and soccer experience is a fun family environment that builds positive character. In order to put this in practice, and to promote a high level of competition and community spirit, the CYSA adopts the following "Codes of Conduct".

ALL PLAYERS PARTICIPATING IN CYSA SHALL:

- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship by example and encourage it from other players, coaches, officials and parents.
- I will view soccer as an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- I will play by the laws of the game.
- I will show respect to other players, the coaches, referees and spectators.
- I will never argue or complain about a referee's call or decision.
- I will play and practice with enthusiasm and dedication.
- I will win with grace and lose with dignity.
- I will remember that winning is only important if I can accept losing, because both are important parts of the game.
- I will accept all consequences for any wrong decision that I make at either practice or during a game.
- I will play my hardest until the final whistle; for both myself and my team.
- I will not partake in drug, alcohol or tobacco use.
