# LOCKER ROOM POLICY

## General Info

- Team Coach or Manager is responsible for the condition of the locker room (LR)
- Coach or Manager must leave a set of keys at the front desk to obtain a LR key
- Coach or Manager must only access assigned LR. See front office for LR assignments
- Players will not be permitted in LR until a coach or manager has obtained a key
- Pick up all trash and tape balls and lock door prior to returning the LR key

## Locker Room Monitoring

- Teams may obtain a LR approximately 30 minutes before their scheduled ice time
- Coach or Manager is responsible for monitoring LR during use
- If Coach or Manager is not inside LR, they are responsible for monitoring the door, permitting only approved team personnel or family members into LR
- Coach or Manager will also be responsible for securing LR while the team is on the ice

## Parents in Locker Rooms

- Parents are permitted in LR for dressing their player when age appropriate
- Coach reserves the right to permit parents access in cases of injury or disability

## Mixed Gender Teams

- If separate LR is not available, then players will take turns using the LR to change
- When possible, male and female players dress/undress in separate LR and then convene in a single LR before the game or practice

## Cell Phones and Other Mobile Recording Devices

- Are not permitted to be used in the locker rooms
- This includes: Cell phones and other mobile devices with recording capabilities, including voice recording, still cameras and video cameras
- If necessary to use phones or other mobile devices, they must be taken outside of LR
- It may be permissible to have Coach or Manager collect phones

## Prohibited Conduct and Reporting

The arena prohibits all types of physical abuse, sexual abuse, emotional abuse, bullying, threats, harassment and hazing, all as described in the USA Hockey SafeSport Handbook. Participants, employees or volunteers may be subject to disciplinary action for violation of these locker room policies or for engaging in any misconduct or abuse that violates the USA Hockey SafeSport Policies.
