

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS AND SPECTATORS
Brooklyn Park Athletic Association - Football

In order to advance the principals of sportsmanship and fair play and to promote mutual respect among players, coaches, umpires and spectators the Brooklyn Park Athletic Association - Football (BPAA) has established this "Code of Conduct" (hereafter referred to as "the Code").

The Code of Conduct shall govern the actions of parents and spectators. The Code is intended to provide behavioral guidance and establish clear expectations for all involved. The Code was not conceived to address every possible behavioral circumstance; however, it shall serve as the Organization's standard for behavioral evaluation.

It shall be the obligation of ALL program parents and spectators, to comply with the terms and provisions of the Code of Conduct. Any person violating the Code shall be subject to administrative action, up to and including termination of his/her privilege to participate in, or attend, any or all BPAA sponsored activities.

Parents and spectators shall remain unconditionally supportive of the Organization's commitment to the ideals of good sportsmanship, team play, honesty, loyalty, courage and respect for authority. In order to adhere to these doctrines the parents and spectators agree as follows:

- Parents and Spectators shall be positive role models.
- Parents and Spectators shall display and instill in all players, the principals of good sportsmanship and team play.
- Parents shall have players to all practices and games on time (Exception: Mandatory school events/players participate in Band, Choir, Plays, Orchestra).
- Parent shall notify the coach of any absences or potential late arrival to games or practices.
- Parents and Spectators shall conduct themselves in a manner that best serves the interests of the players.
- Parents and Spectators shall do their best to provide the players a positive and fun experience.
- Parents shall make certain that their children show respect for all other players, coaches, officials and spectators.
- Parents and Spectators shall not ridicule or demean players, coaches or umpires.
- Parents shall inform the coach of any disability or ailment that may affect the safety of their child.
- Parents and Spectators shall treat all players, coaches and umpires fairly and with respect.
- Parents and Spectators shall comply with the decisions of league officials and observe all rules, policy and procedure as established or endorsed by the BPAA league.
- Parents and Spectators shall not question a referee's call.
- Parents and Spectators shall respect the opponent and avoid any confrontation with opposing players, spectators, or coaches.
- Parents and Spectators shall be alcohol, drug and tobacco free while on any BPAA athletic fields.
- Any changes or alterations made to the equipment issued by BPAA Football will release them of any liability if the child is injured.
