During Bruce's tenure, 156 Bangor athletes qualified for the state track & field meet, while 294 were conference champions. Bangor did not have a track facility during Coach Brewer's first 20 years. Coach Brewer also hosted numerous WIAA Regional and Sectional Track & Field Meets.
