Where We Started

In 2011, the Corning Gaffer Travel Lacrosse Program began and was comprised primarily of Corning Hawk Varsity lacrosse players. The program has grown to include elite players from 15 different school districts and continues to grow. The mission of the Gaffers was to provide players the opportunity to attend major recruitment tournaments and play in front of college coaches.

Coach Streeten's personal relationships with most Division I, II and III programs has assisted him in sending more than 300 players to play at the collegiate level.

In the fall of 2014 the Gaffer Elite Lacrosse program was formed and fields a total of four teams:

Class of 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019. The teams have a total of 65 players and will have a tryout to add players to a maximum of 80 in May.
