

2015 USAYESS SWEEPSTAKES MODEL

Objective:

To help teams, state organizations and the national organization create operating funds separate from any funds gifted by Larry and Brenda Potterfield. Donations made to the state organization directly will help as donations from donors other than MidwayUSA Foundation. All donations are tax deductible.

Program:

- Each state organization will receive five tickets per athlete.
- Each state organization will receive one free poster. Teams need to download poster as needed from the USAYESS website.
- Summit Safe dealers will receive two posters and 100 tickets. Any donations made to USAYESS through a
 Summit Safe dealer will be split 50-50 with the USAYESS state affiliate should one exist, and USAYESS
 Headquarters. Summit Safe dealer please have checks made out to USAYESS, and mail tickets and donations
 to USAYESS Headquarters at; USAYESS Sweepstakes P.O. Box 1022 Colville, WA 99114. Send tickets and
 donations based on the schedule below.
- The team treasurer should be responsible for keeping track of tickets and donations, and forwarding funds to the state organization and USAYESS Headquarters along with any unused tickets based on the schedule below.
- Teams should have check made out to their team. Then send \$12.50 of each ticket to their state organization, and \$25 of each ticket along the ticket stub to USAYESS. Send tickets and donations based on the schedule below.
- For each \$50 donation, the donor receives one ticket. Donors may make unlimited donates.
- Of the \$50, the state organization keeps \$12.50 (25%), and the team keeps \$12.50 (25%).
- If the donation is made to the state organization, the state organization keeps \$25 (50%).
- State affiliate must have an IRS 501 c (3) Letter of Determination or show proof of mailed application. Should there be no state affiliate, 100% of the proceeds will belong to USAYESS. USAYESS reserves the right to accept donations on a state's behalf.
- Any donations made directly to USAYESS Headquarters, will become property of USAYESS Headquarters.
- All unsold tickets must be returned to USAYESS Headquarters.
- Teams may download as many fliers as needed. Fliers are two-sided.
- Firearms must be transferred to a person of legal age through an FFL dealer.
- Must be 18 years of age to participate.
- Donations are tax deductible.

Dates:

Early-Bird drawing will be held July 4th in San Antonio, TX at the Jr Clay Target National Championship. Drawing will be for; 1st prize GoPro version 4 & five raffle tickets, 2nd prize \$200 Sportsman's Warehouse or Cabela's Gift Card & five raffle tickets, 3rd prize \$100 Sportsman's Warehouse or Cabela's Gift Card. Cut-Off date for the Early Bird drawing will be June 20th, 2015, except at the USAYESS National Championship, where tickets may be sold up to one hour before drawing at 4:00 p.m.. Mail all collected donations and stubs to USAYESS no later than June 20th, 2015. Keep unused tickets in order to continue on with the Sweepstakes. All Early Bird tickets will be put back into main drawing the Main drawing which will be held on October 1, 2015, in Colville, WA at 5:00 pm.

Main drawing will be held on October 1, 2015, in Colville, WA at 5:00 pm. Cut Off date for the Main Drawing will be September 20th, 2015. Mail donations and all stubs to USAYESS no later than Sept 20th, 2015.
