2023 Summer 3on3 Half ice rules

- 1. Games will consist of:
 - a. One 24 minute, running time period
 - b. Each team will play 2 games, back-to-back
 - c. 2 minute warm-up before the 1st game of the one hour block
 - d. 8U Division Only, there will be a 90 second buzzer to make line changes
- 2. Games are 3-on-3.... Three skaters and a goalie on each team.
- 3. Adding Players.... A coach will only be able to add players in the following situations:
 - a. Team has NO goalie
 - b. Team has 4 skaters or less

When this happens, the players will need to be cleared with the 3-on-3 Coordinator, Nick Staely, prior to the game.

- 4. The Referee will drop the puck at the center ice dot:
 - a. To start each game
 - b. After each goal
 - c. After any Penalty shot
- 5. If a penalty is assessed by the referee, a penalty shot will be awarded. After the penalty shot, the referee will drop the puck at the center ice dot regardless if the penalty shot results in a goal or not. If a penalty shot is awarded at the end of the period and the buzzer sounds before the shot can be taken, the penalty shot will still be taken with 0:00 on the time clock.
- 6. MIHOA Referees will officiate all games.
- 7. When the goalie freezes the puck, the referee will blow the whistle and the Offensive team will back up to center ice, as the Defensive team takes over possession of the puck. The puck becomes LIVE once the Defensive team moves the puck forward.
- 8. The decision of the Referee on ALL goals is final and non-negotiable.
- 9. NO Slap Shots allowed at any level.
- 10. Overtime Rules (Any game tied at the end of the 24 minute game)
 - a. 3 minute running-time Sudden Death
 - b. If still tied, there will be a 3 person "shoot-out"
 - c. If still tied, both teams will send out one shooter each, until a winner is determined

Each team must use all skaters to shoot, before they can re-use a shooter.
