Bubble players for both CSDHL teams will be offered spots on the Prospects Team.

"We have been exploring the possibility of adding a Prospects Division for the past several years and we feel CSDHL is ready to move forward with this opportunity to give more young hockey players in the Midwest, as well as clubs throughout the United States, the chance to play and develop at the elite Tier II level that Central States offers," says Jim Wright, CSDHL President.

Teams will play a full league schedule against other teams in the Prospects Division and playoffs will be held at the end of the season.
